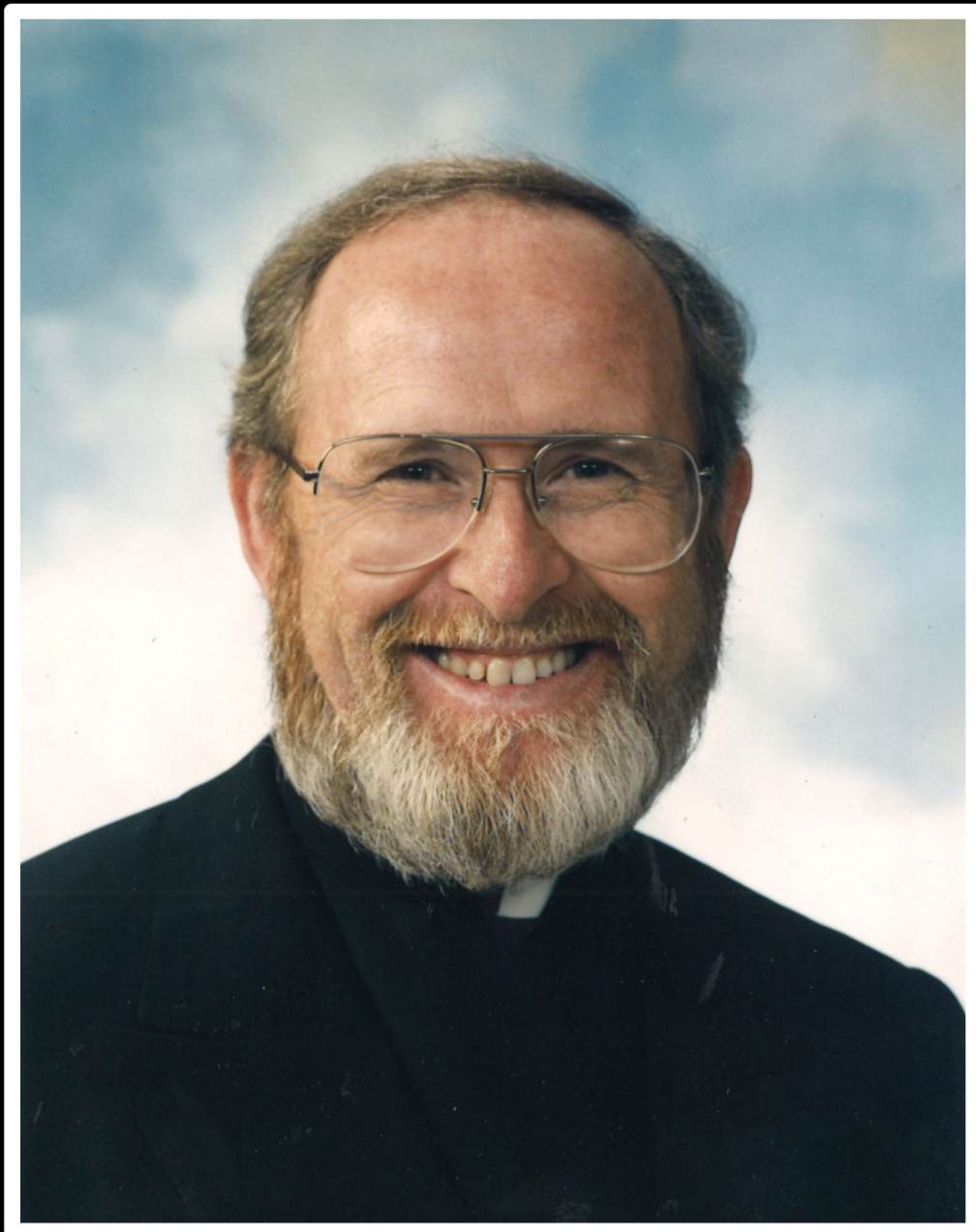

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

The past few days have been very difficult, as we reflect on the untimely passing of our beloved pastor, Fr. Mike Gleeson, RIP. We intend to dedicate a water well to Fr. Gleeson in Uganda. We appeal for funds for the Fr. Mike Gleeson Well.

Wells Of Life (wellsoflife.org) has built 400 wells since 2008, serving 400,000 of the poorest. Each well serves 1,000 people and costs \$6,000. With a well, local infant mortality drops by 50%, and girls are freed up to attend school. The need is great.

Wells Of Life will create a beautiful photobook of the well for our parish. WOL has a 100% donation model. Any donations over \$6,000 will go to the next well. Not a penny is wasted!

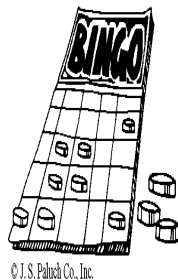
CATHOLIC BASEBALL LEAGUE
